What is Clear Choices Clean Water?

Clear Choices Clean Water is a campaign to increase awareness about choices we make and the impact they have on our streams and lakes. Water quality friendly lawn care includes practices such as using phosphorus-free fertilizer, landscaping with native plants, managing yard and pet wastes, and properly maintaining septic systems. By educating individuals on these important actions and giving them the tools they need to make these essential changes in their own yards, we will empower them to do their part for water quality.

How and when did this campaign start?

The Watershed Foundation (TWF), White River Alliance (WRA), and the IUPUI Center for Earth and Environmental Science (CEES) teamed up in 2010 to implement this unique strategy to increase awareness and knowledge about residential yard choices and their impacts on water quality in our watersheds. The focus began in Indiana but is spreading across the country.

PS, if you aren't sure what a watershed is, check out our pledge map to see the landscape boundaries that define the area of land that drains to each of our major Indiana streams - these areas/physical land boundaries are a stream's 'watershed'.
